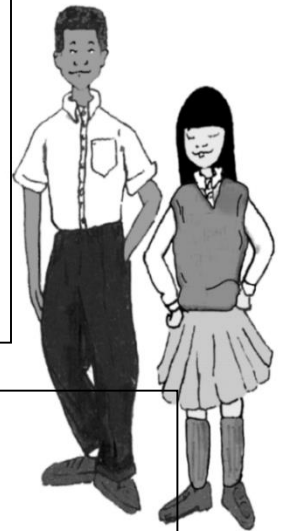
Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Elementary School Unified Dress Code

MLK Elementary School has a Unified Dress Code Policy. The unified dress code is in effect Monday through Friday each week. MLK Elementary School spirit shirts may be worn with uniform bottoms on any day of the week. ***Jeans are not allowed unless specified by the administration.*** The following attire is acceptable for the MLK Elementary Unified Dress Code:

Slacks, Pants, Shorts, Jumpers, Capris, Skirts, Skorts

Solid khaki, navy, or black

- Pleated or flat front (length must not touch the floor)
- Fitted at the waist
- Belt must be worn with apparel that have belt loops (at all times)
- No baggy/saggy or tight fitting pants
- Plain/unembellished
- No shorter than 2 inches above the knee and touches the student's fingertips when measured (skirts, skorts, and jumpers)



Shirts, Blouses

Solid white, black, gold, yellow, or red

- Appropriately sized and tucked into pants and/or skirt
- Long or short sleeves, polo style, oxford, plain/unembellished
- Straight, button-down or turtle neck collar
- Non-collared King Elementary spirit wear may be worn with uniform bottoms
- Sweatshirts and sweaters (pullover or cardigan) may be worn



Additional information

- Socks must be worn and shoes must have closed toes with backs and heels no higher than 2 inches. Shoes with laces must be tied.
- Hats, caps, hoods, bandannas, and scarves may not be worn while in the building.
- Athletic shoes are preferred (white soles)
- Scout uniforms accepted
- No gaudy (excessively large) jewelry will be acceptable
- Clothing with frayed ends, holes, fading, and camouflage are not permitted
- All other items, in the judgment of the principal (or designee), which disrupt or distract from the learning process are not permitted.
